Classroom Happenings

Reading- During class read-alouds we are working on asking and answering questions about key details in a text and identifying the number of syllables in spoken words.

Writing-We have worked on pattern writing where some part sentence on every page repeats with one detail changing. (ex- On Thanksgiving I like to have . Repeats on next page.) Math-We have been working on more and less and will start to explore teen numbers and how they are formed using a ten frame and some "extras." This quarter students are expected to count to 40 by ones and tens and count to 40 from any starting point (not just one). They must also be able to read and write numbers from 0-20.

Social Studies-In December we will start a new unit on wants and needs. During the week of December 11th we will put our learning into practice with a collaborative learning opportunity called Holiday Workshop.
